Denver Public Schools (DPS) Transportation Services thanks you for your unwavering support of your child's education. Another promising new school year is upon us, and Transportation Services is committed to provide the most equitable services possible to support our district's vision of *Every Child Succeeds*.

As established by Board of Education policy, your student is eligible for school bus transportation for the 2014-15 school year. Please review your child's bus information below, and familiarize yourselves with the bus stop location, pick-up and drop-off times, and route numbers. Students are asked to arrive at their assigned bus stop 10 minutes prior to the scheduled pick-up time. *Note: these times are subject to change. Any changes will be communicated via the DPS Parent Portal and your respective school front office.*

Please verify your student's school start date with his/her respective school as these can vary across DPS. Likewise, please ensure your student has their +Pass on the first day of school, as well as each and every day. This +Pass is essential to ride a DPS school bus, and your cooperation in helping us reinforce this with your student(s) will help us improve goals toward enhanced student safety and better communication with our DPS families.

The Transportation Services team is dedicated to ensuring that students arrive to school safely, on time and ready to learn. Collaboration and teamwork amongst transportation staff, students, parents and schools are vital to this commitment. Transportation is an extension of the school day and supports learning outside of the classroom. While riding the school bus, students are expected to uphold the same standards of behavior as in the classroom.
