Another promising new school year is upon us, and Transportation Services is committed to provide the most equitable services possible through programs like Success Express in support of our district's vision of *Every Child Succeeds*.

Success Express circulates in the Far Northeast and Near Northeast neighborhoods to offer students multiple opportunities to catch a ride to school. All students attending participating schools in this region are eligible. This service also allows for more flexible school days and access for students to their school of choice. DPS students can access the bus at any stop from 6:30 - 9:30 a.m., and 2:30 - 6:30 p.m. Attached is a copy of shuttle schedule for your child's school. *Note: these times are subject to change.* Changes and updates will be communicated via your school and in the DPS Parent Portal. Please verify your student's school start date with his/her respective school as these can vary across DPS. Likewise, please ensure your student has their +Pass on the first day of school, as well as each and every day.
